1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The rules are changed so that membership in the class association is not required.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Participation in this regatta is by invitation only. All participants must be approved for this event by the head instructor or program head of their member program (NCS, NYC, GHYC.)
- 2.2 Opti sailors shall be juniors who have not reached their 16th birthday in 2009.
- 2.3 All applicants must complete the registration, waiver/release, and medical release forms and submit the required fee by no later than July 17, 2009.
- 2.4 The organizing authority, may in its sole discretion, accept any late entry.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$10 per participant, if received on or before July 10, 2009.
- 3.2 Registrations received after July 17, 2009 are subject to an additional late fee of \$5, for a total of \$15.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available July 24, 2009 at check in at the Jobson Sailing Center at the Great Harbor Yacht Club

7 COURSES

8 SCORING

Multiple races are scheduled of which one completed race will constitute a regatta.

9 PRIZES

Awards will be presented at the cookout on July 17.

10 SAFETY

All competitors shall wear, while on the water, US Coast Guard approved PFD, except for brief periods while changing clothing. The penalty for breach of this rule is DSQ, without a hearing.

11 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The regatta organizers, the Great Harbor Yacht Club, race committee, protest committee, volunteers, sponsors, agents, employees, or any other organization or official providing services at the request of any of the foregoing in connection with the events will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any person sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, and crews) and each parent or guardian of a competitor under the age of 18, individually and on behalf of his or her minor child, agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
