NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The Jobson Race Series will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- .1 The series is open to all boats of the following classes:
 - Alerions
 - Rhodes 19
 - Herreshoff 12^{1/2} & Haven
- .2 All competitors must sign up to race in the Jobson Race Series by 12 noon on the day of racing.
- .3 All competitors must sign a medical waiver before commencing racing. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification. It is the skipper's responsibility to ensure that all members of the crew have completed a medical waiver. Waivers are available at the Jobson Sailing Center and on the GHYC website.

3 FEES

Individual Sign up GHYC owned boat:	\$25
GHYC member owned boat with no coach:	\$25
Non-GHYC boat:	\$50/month

4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- .1 The Jobson Race Series will commence on the July 1st and will be scheduled to run subsequently every Thursday evening until the 9th of September. Racing will be suspended on August 19th for Nantucket Race Week.
- .2 The July races shall be held on July 1st, 8th, 15st, 22th, and 29th all on Thursdays.
- .3 The August races shall be held on August 5th, 12th, and 26th all on Thursdays.
- .4 The September races shall be held on September 2nd and 9th all on Thursdays.
- .5 A competitors meeting will be held at 1530 at the Jobson Sailing Center.
- .6 Conditions permitting, multiple races will be sailed every race day.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions, including the courses to be sailed, will be posted on the Great Harbor Yacht Club website and will be available at all competitors meetings and at the Jobson Sailing Center.



6 VENUE

The races will be held in Nantucket Harbor. The racing area will be announced at the competitors meeting every race day and posted on the official notice board.

7 PENALTY SYSTEM

.1 V1 PENALTY AT THE TIME OF AN INCIDENT

The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident while racing. However, when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 while in the zone around a mark other than a starting mark, her penalty shall be a Two Turns Penalty.'

.2 V2 POST-RACE PENALTIES

(a) Provided that rule 44.1 (b) does not apply, a boat that may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 or rule 31 in an incident may take a Post-Race Penalty at any time after the race until the beginning of a protest hearing involving the incident.

(b) A Post-Race Penalty is a 30% Scoring Penalty calculated as stated in rule 44.3(c). However, rule 44.1(a) applies.

(c) A boat takes a Post-Race Penalty by delivering to the race office a written statement that she accepts the penalty and that identifies the race number and where and when the incident occurred.

8 SCORING

.1 The Low Point Scoring System will be used for each day.

.2 No race will be excluded for daily prizes

9 PRIZES

.1 Daily awards will be presented immediately after racing each day at the GHYC Fuel Bar.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (the Great Harbor Yacht Club, Race Committee, Protest Committee, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any person sustained as a result of participation in the Jobson Race Series. By participating in the Jobson Sailing Series, each competitor (owners, skippers, crews and supporting persons) agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the Jobson Race Series to the fullest extent permitted by law.



11 RISK STATEMENT

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (GHYC, individual boat owners, race committee, protest committee, or any other organization or official) will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. By participating in the GHYC Foundation Regatta, each competitor (skippers, crew, paid crew and support persons) agrees to release the above race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in the GHYC Jobson Race Series to the fullest extent permitted by law.

.1 Clean Regatta

This regatta is a Sailors for the Sea "Clean Regatta." Great Harbor Yacht Club is committed to maintaining Nantucket's clean waters and shores. All participants are encouraged to follow the goals and requirements of the Clean Regattas program.



12 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate third-party liability insurance.
